is a Christian medical GP who has built up an extensive practice in The Hague. He is a well-known charismatic speaker in The Netherlands. Peter has recently retired from full-time work in his practice, which is now run by members of his family who are also doctors. The practice attracts a large number of Muslim patients who live in The Hague.

As well as his medical treatment of patients, Peter prays for the sick and teaches others to pray for those who need healing. He regularly travels to Africa and the Far East for the overseas mission that he set up some years ago. Peter has seen many miracles of healing occur in The Hague and overseas.
